Summer Reading Programs

Royal Crown Club (Read-To-Me): Ages 2 - Kindergarten

This special reading club is for children who cannot yet read independently or who still need help with their reading. Children in this club will be required to listen to 30 books during the month of June. Parents and children should register for this program at the library beginning June 1. The children will receive a book log to list the books that they have listened to. This program will end on June 30.

Shield Club (Beginner): Grades 1 - 3

Sword Club (Intermediate): Grades 4 - 8

The summer reading clubs will run from June 1 through July 17. Children must register at the Children's Library or online for these clubs. Children registering for the Beginner Club will have a goal of reading 15 books during the 6-week period. Children joining the Intermediate Club will have a goal of reading 7 "chapter books". Each child who completes the reading program will be given a certificate and a prize. Each child will also be given a chance to enter a drawing for various prizes when they complete their program. Children should turn in their reading logs on Monday, July 18 or Tuesday, July 19.

All children who complete the reading program are invited to a "Medieval Party" on Wednesday, July 20 at 6:00 pm. They will receive their certificates and prize at the party. The prize drawings will also be at this time.
